### ■ FRAMINGHAM HEART STUDY

The people of Framingham proudly participate in this National Institutes of Health-funded program—the longest running epidemiological study in history. Started in 1948 and run by BU for 40 years, the study has taught us almost everything we know about cardiovascular risk factors. Scientists worldwide use the study's clinical data, with more than 3,000 articles based on that data published in peer-reviewed medical journals since 1951.
