The Global Health, Safety & Environment department of the Novartis Institutes for BioMedical Research (NIBR) is seeking an intern to support the development and implementation of several key programs. This is an excellent opportunity to gain first-hand industry experience in the HSE field in the pharmaceutical research sector.

This is a paid internship position for a minimum period of 3 months, with the possibility of extending through December, 2013. Work hours are somewhat flexible depending upon the schedule of the selected candidate and may range from 24 to 40 hours per week. It is based in Cambridge, MA.

Minimally, qualified candidates should be pursuing or recently completed a degree in safety management, industrial hygiene, environmental health or engineering, occupational health or medicine, biology, chemistry or a related field. It is open to both undergrads and graduate students.

Projects may include the following, among others:

- Supporting implementation of NIBR HSE Compliance Assurance Strategy.
- Supporting the implementation of the Novartis risk portfolio database for several NIBR sites.
- Assisting with the development and execution of a lab ventilation survey of NIBR sites.
- Developing an industrial hygiene exposure assessment framework for NIBR.
