H. Jack Geiger

H. Jack Geiger, MD, launched the Community Health Center Model in the United States – a network that now provides primary care for 28 million low-income patients – in 1965, with health centers in the Mississippi Delta and Boston. He is a founding member and past president of Physicians for Social Responsibility and Physicians for Human Rights, which shared in the Nobel Peace Prize in 1986 and 1988, respectively.
