Stephanie on Travel Grants

We received 20 applications for spring 2009

Question: what sort of dean/faculty involvement is necessary in evaluating applications?

- --Dean Whitaker doesn't seem overly interested in participating
- --Seems best to have some faculty involvement, to maintain neutrality and offer expertise perhaps from a department with no student applicants?
- --If no faculty member volunteers, perhaps add another student to the committee to balance arts/sciences evaluators

Marc will draft email to faculty members and send to GSO members to be forwarded to departments, requesting faculty participation

Remember: a department must have attended three meetings per semester in order for its students to be eligible for travel grants

Marc on Policy

Health Care: working with SAGE to draft a second letter to deans to request increased health care benefits for graduate students (deans seem receptive to arguing on our behalf); using statistics collected through a SAGE questionnaire in letter

- --We want the default Student Complete Plan (\$1500/year premium) to be converted to Student Plus Plan (\$2000/year premium); would increase coverage from 80% to 100% and drug cap from \$2,500 to \$250,000
- --Other option would be to request dental insurance, but better health insurance seems a more feasible (and reachable) goal

Co-sponsored Events policies will be reexamined in the coming year

Misc.

High cost of poster printing (approx. \$250) – should GSO purchase a poster printer for grad students?

- --Or perhaps departments with poster printers should collaborate and contract their printers out to departments sans printers?
- --Committee to be formed and Deans to be notified of this concern at next meeting

NAGPS – Marc posted information about this organization online – looking to recruit new members (\$500 membership fees) – SAGE seems amenable, but have contacted Law or Business

Dean offered us the chance to plan Orientation for all new students – dean-funded, student-planned

- --Should include a social event, a tour, and an informational meeting or two
- --Need committee proposal letter to be submitted by Memorial Day
