### **A. Outreach Strategies**

1. Approximately how long, and what level of effort does it take to get someone engaged in HIV-oriented primary care, and what factors are associated engagement?
2. What level of effort does it take to keep someone retained in HIV-oriented primary care, and what factors are associated with retention?

### **B. Population Descriptions**

3. What are the characteristics of clients who are engaged in HIV-oriented primary care, versus those who are not engaged in care?
4. What are the characteristics of clients who are retained in HIV-oriented primary care, versus those who are not retained in care?

### **C. Barriers and Facilitators**

5. Are there differences in barriers and facilitators among individuals engaged and not engaged in HIV-oriented primary care?
6. Are there differences in barriers and facilitators among individuals retained and not retained in HIV-oriented primary care?

### **D. Case Management**

7. Does participation in case management facilitate a client's engagement and retention in HIV-oriented primary care?

### **E. Medical Outcomes**

8. Is the level of retention in care associated with changes in key medical outcomes? (CD4, viral load)

### **F. Quality of Life**

9. Are individuals who are retained in HIV-oriented primary care more likely to show improvement in quality of life?
