

INSTRUCTIONS:

- In addition to this application, you must also complete a 2017-2018 Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA). Boston University's Federal School Code is 002130.
- LL.M. students must be registered for at least six credit hours per semester to qualify for Federal Direct Loans.
- Be sure to request the loan amount you need for the full academic year. The amount you request will be divided into two equal disbursements. For students enrolled in both the fall and spring semesters, half of the loan will be disbursed at the beginning of the fall semester and half in the beginning of the spring semester. For students enrolled for only one semester of the academic year, half of the loan will be disbursed in the beginning of that semester and half will be disbursed at the midpoint of the semester.
- Origination fees will be deducted from each loan disbursement. Complete loan terms and conditions can be found at <https://studentaid.ed.gov/types/loans/subsidized-unsubsidized>.
- If this is the first time borrowing Federal Direct Stafford Loans as a student at the School of Law, you must complete a Master Promissory Note online at www.studentloans.gov. Students need only sign one Master Promissory Note for all Direct Loan borrowing during their degree program.
- Students borrowing a Federal Direct Stafford Loan for the first time must complete a mandatory Entrance Counseling Session. The session can be completed online at www.studentloans.gov.
