

Education and Training:

The Office of Sponsored Programs has initiated a number of efforts to keep faculty and staff up-to-date on export control regulations and issues. Some examples of these efforts include:

1. OSP's website, available at <http://www.bu.edu/osp>, contains the most current information distributed by the University. This website also links directly to MIT's Export Controls Boot Camp.
2. OSP requires engineering and science faculty to complete an export control checklist for all new research projects submitted to OSP for proposal review. At the time of award OSP works with investigators to make a final determination as to whether or not the research is subject to the regulations. Investigators are directed to work with Office of General Counsel to obtain licenses if required.
3. OSP publishes memoranda and other communications providing information on current export control issues.
4. When requested, OSP representatives make presentations to departments and centers tailored to address their specific concerns.
