

# Adventure Camp 2008 Staff Salary Information

Adventure Specialists (under 21 years of age) (Ropes, Tower, Biking, Waterfront)	\$1,800 – 2,350 for the season
Adventure Specialists (over 21 years of age) (Ropes, Tower, Biking, Waterfront)	\$1,850 – 2,500 for the season
Trip Leaders	\$1,900 – 2,600 for the season
Adventure Trek Leaders (under 21 years of age)	\$1,800 – 2,350 for the season
Adventure Trek Leaders (over 21 years of age)	\$1,850 – 2,500 for the season

Administrative and Support Staff salary ranges are available from the Adventure Camp Director.

and current certifications.**

## Staff Training Components:

All staff members are expected to participate in “Full Staff Training” which will begin on **June 16<sup>th</sup>, 2008**. All Trip Leaders, Adventure Trek Leaders, and Adventure Specialists must also participate in “Specialized Training” which will begin on **June 9<sup>th</sup> 2007**. Waterfront Specialists are expected to participate in Waterfront Training which will begin on or shortly after **June 9<sup>th</sup> TBA**. If for some reason a staff member is excused from attending all or part of the appropriate trainings, the salary will be adjusted accordingly. The stipend for each staff training component has been included in the Pay Range for the Season.

## Certification Training:

We are pleased to offer the following certification trainings to our staff:

### **Wilderness First Aid, Wilderness First Aid recertification, and Wilderness First Responder**

**Recertification** will be offered at Sargent Center on June 9 & 10, 2007. This training is open to the public at a regular rate but the contracted Adventure Camp staff rate is approximately \$100. An adult CPR course will tentatively be offered on June 9 or 10 depending on enrollment. The fee for this CPR course would be \$35.

### **Red Cross Lifeguard certification and CPR for the Professional Rescuer**

**Note:** The new Red Cross Lifeguard certification and CPR for the Professional Rescuer certification are going into effect as of January 30, 2007. This is the new curriculum for both courses and is appropriate for those wishing to become a certified lifeguard for the first time or for someone who has been a lifeguard.

**“Recertification” for currently certified people is NOT an option; therefore everyone that will need to renew these certifications will be required to take the FULL courses.** Both courses will be offered prior to Specialized Training during the week of June 4-8. An exact schedule will be determined as soon as the final course curriculum is available from the Red Cross. The Lifeguarding course will be held at a local outdoor swimming pool. The pool will have just opened so the water is usually very cold. The fee for Lifeguard certification which includes CPR for the Professional Rescuer will be about \$60. CPR for the Professional Rescuer will be about \$15. Exact fees will be determined as soon as the course materials are determined by the Red Cross.
