To major in philosophy a student takes a sequence of nine courses as outlined below. Students must earn a minimum grade of C in courses taken toward the major.

2. PH 310 History of Modern Philosophy
3. PH 160 Reasoning and Argumentation or PH 360* Symbolic Logic
4. PH 350 History of Ethics
5. one course from PH 403 – 439 _____
6. one other 400-level course** _____
7. & 8. two other PH courses at the 200 level or higher

9. one other philosophy course _____

* PH 360 recommended for students with interests in philosophy of knowledge, language, logic, or science.

** A "Topics" course (PH 480 - 487) is recommended for students planning on graduate study in philosophy.
