4.	PH 350 History of Ethics
5.	☐ one course from PH 403 – 439
6.	one other 400-level course**
7.	& 8. two other PH courses at the 200 level or higher &
9.	one other philosophy course

^{*} PH 360 recommended for students with interests in philosophy of knowledge, language, logic, or science.

^{**} A "Topics" course (PH 480 - 487) is recommended for students planning on graduate study in philosophy.
