

The Department of Political Science at Boston University invites applications for a tenure-track position at the Assistant Professor level in American political behavior for an anticipated start date of September 1, 2010 (pending budgetary approval). Particular areas of interest include public opinion, voting behavior, social movements, and civic engagement, and related areas of US political life. Desirable, in addition, are comparative interests linking the US context with that of other polities. Candidates will be expected to teach undergraduate courses, including Introduction to American Politics, and graduate courses, including a core seminar in American politics, as well as other courses in their specialty. Ph.D. must be completed by Sept. 1, 2010.

Previous teaching experience is highly desirable.
