

Advising Network

The Advising Network of the Office of the Provost provides a forum for faculty and professional academic advisors from across campus to advise the university's senior leadership, address issues of common concern, work on joint projects, and share ideas and best practices for guiding and supporting our undergraduate students' education and overall development. The Advising Network reaches out to all faculty advisors and professional advisors by organizing opportunities for advisors to meet and work together (informal brown bag lunches, annual conferences, focus groups or symposia on particular topics, workshops, speakers, etc.). As needed, the Advising Network will form working groups or planning committees that draw in other members of the advising community.

Agendas for Advising Network meetings are jointly set by the co-chairs and the members. The Advising Network meets monthly and is staffed by the Office of the Provost.

Membership of the Advising Network:

- Associate Provost for Undergraduate Affairs (co-chair)
- Professional/Faculty Advisor (co-chair)
- One professional and one faculty advisor from each undergraduate school or college (including MET), with 4 faculty and 3 professional advisors from CAS, preferably faculty member from each of the following: Humanities, Social Sciences, Natural Sciences, and Math/Computer Sciences. At least one representative from each school/college should be someone who oversees advising in the school/college, and at least one should be an advisor in the trenches.

- A CAS foreign language Advisor
- Advisor, Kilachand Honors College
- Director, Educational Resource Center
- Director, University Service Center
- Director, Center for Career Development
- Director, Orientation
- Director, Student Athletic Support
- Two representatives from Study Abroad
- Two representatives from the Office of the Provost: Assistant Provost for Academic Affairs and Special Advisor to the Provost for Student Choices and Transitions
- Affiliate Members: University Registrar, Associate Librarian for Undergraduate and Distance Learning, Director of Residence Life, Director of Student Health Services and of Behavioral Medicine (or designees)
