1. List the learning outcomes for the program: While these are all applicable across Sargent undergraduate programs, the first three are most appropriate for a Sargent-wide analysis. Outcomes “d” and “e” are of primary interest to a subset.

- a) Students will demonstrate foundation knowledge and laboratory skills in the natural and behavioral sciences.
- b) They will display the ability to read, write, speak and listen so that they can reach independent conclusions, address complex problems and communicate persuasively.
- c) Students will build the quantitative, technological and analytical skills needed to synthesize relevant information and arrive at valid conclusions.
- d) They will identify the multi-disciplinary components of human behavior necessary to understand cultural contexts and respect individual variability.
- e) They will be introduced to the Institute of Medicine core values for all health care services. These include the framework that healthcare should be safe, effective, efficient, patient-centered, timely and equitable.
