1. List the learning outcomes for the program:

- Students will demonstrate broad knowledge of the global history of art, architecture and material culture
- Students will have a command of four geographically and temporally different areas, defined as follows: A (Ancient, Medieval or Ancient American); B (Asian, African or Islamic); C (Renaissance, Baroque or Eighteenth-Century); D (19th century, 20th century, or Latin American)
- Students will demonstrate familiarity with different methodologies in the history of art, architecture and material culture
- Students will develop and be able to apply visual and verbal analytic skills
- Students will be trained in research methods
- Students will learn to produce a cogent argument based on visual and verbal analysis of artworks and original and secondary sources, research findings, and creative thinking
- Students will master oral and written communication of cogent arguments in a language that is appropriate to the field.
