- II. Advisor-advisee relationship

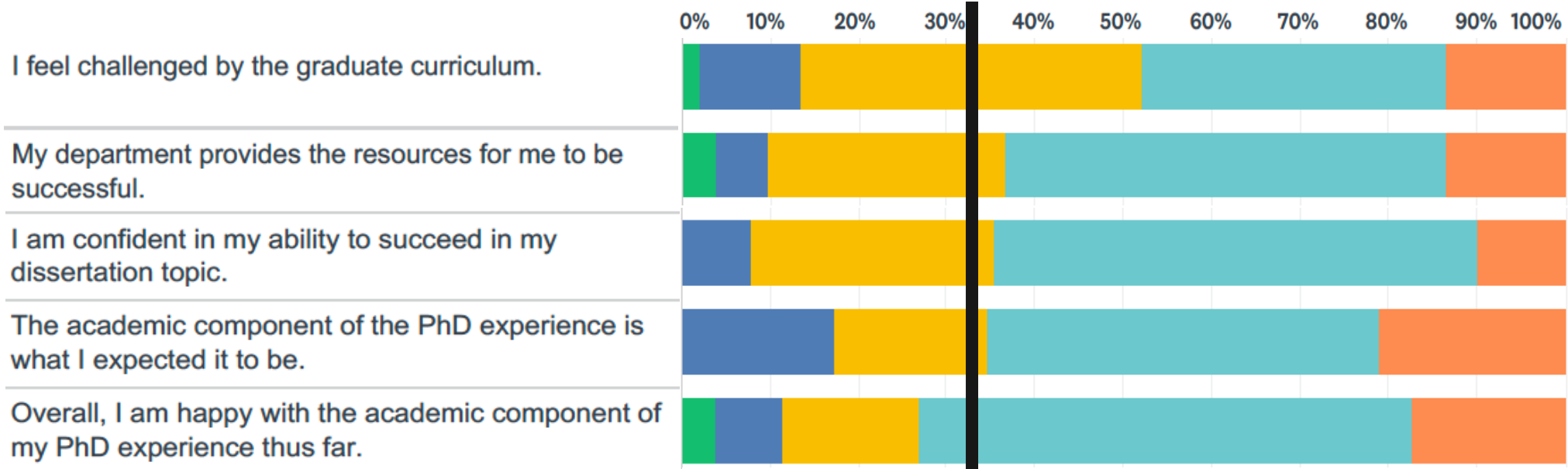
- **Administration**

My goals in my research project are well defined.

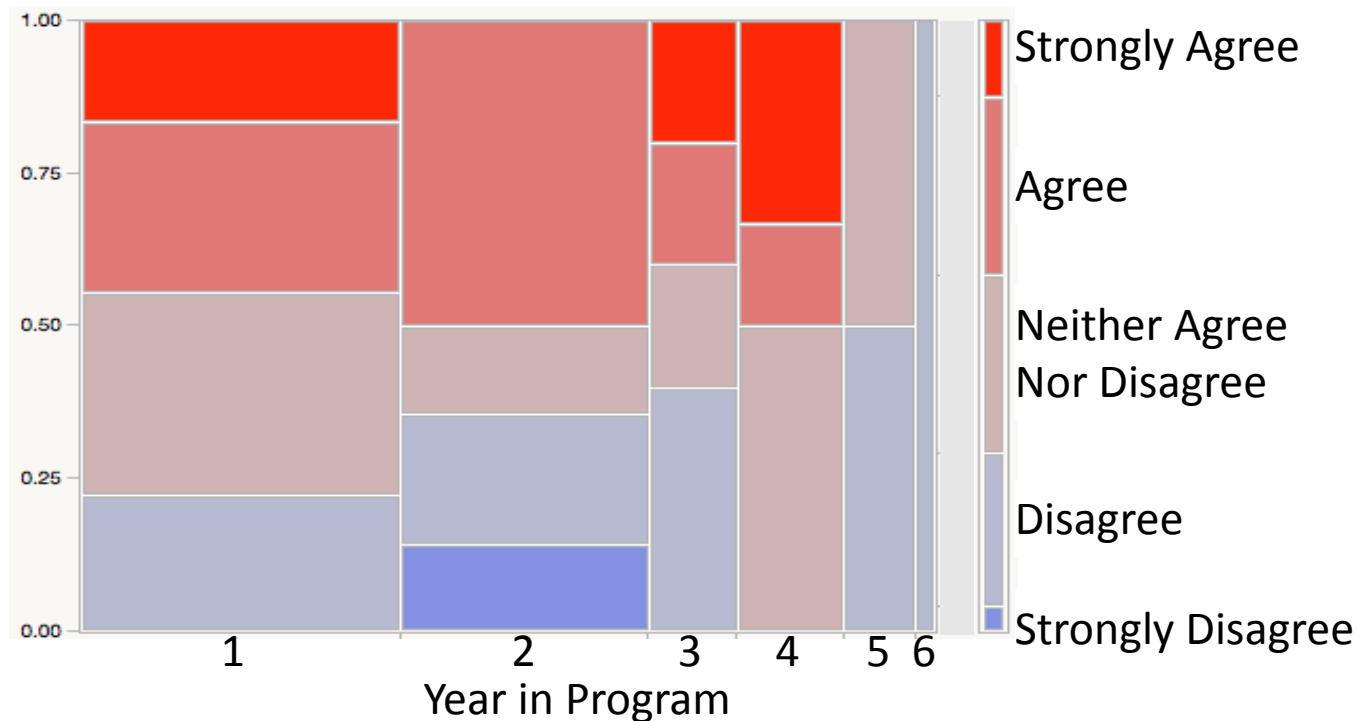
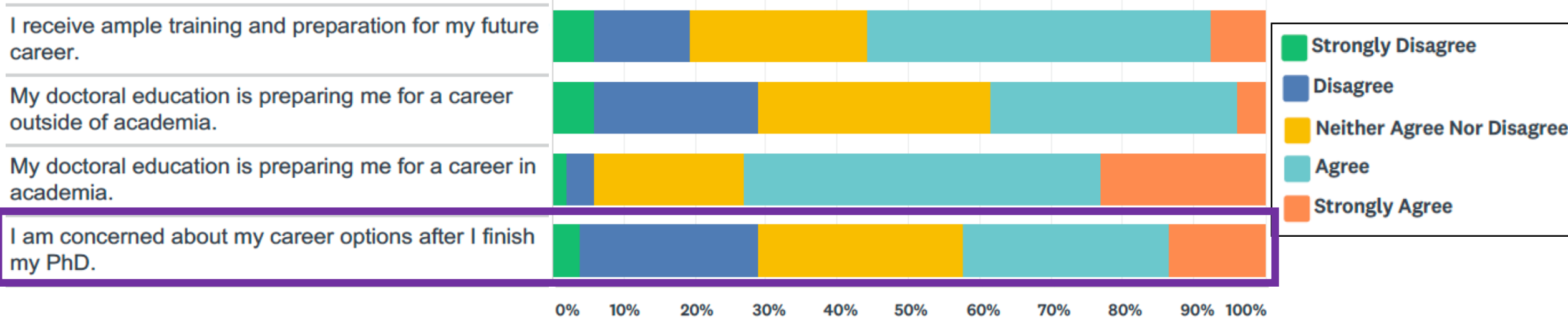
My workload is overwhelming at times.



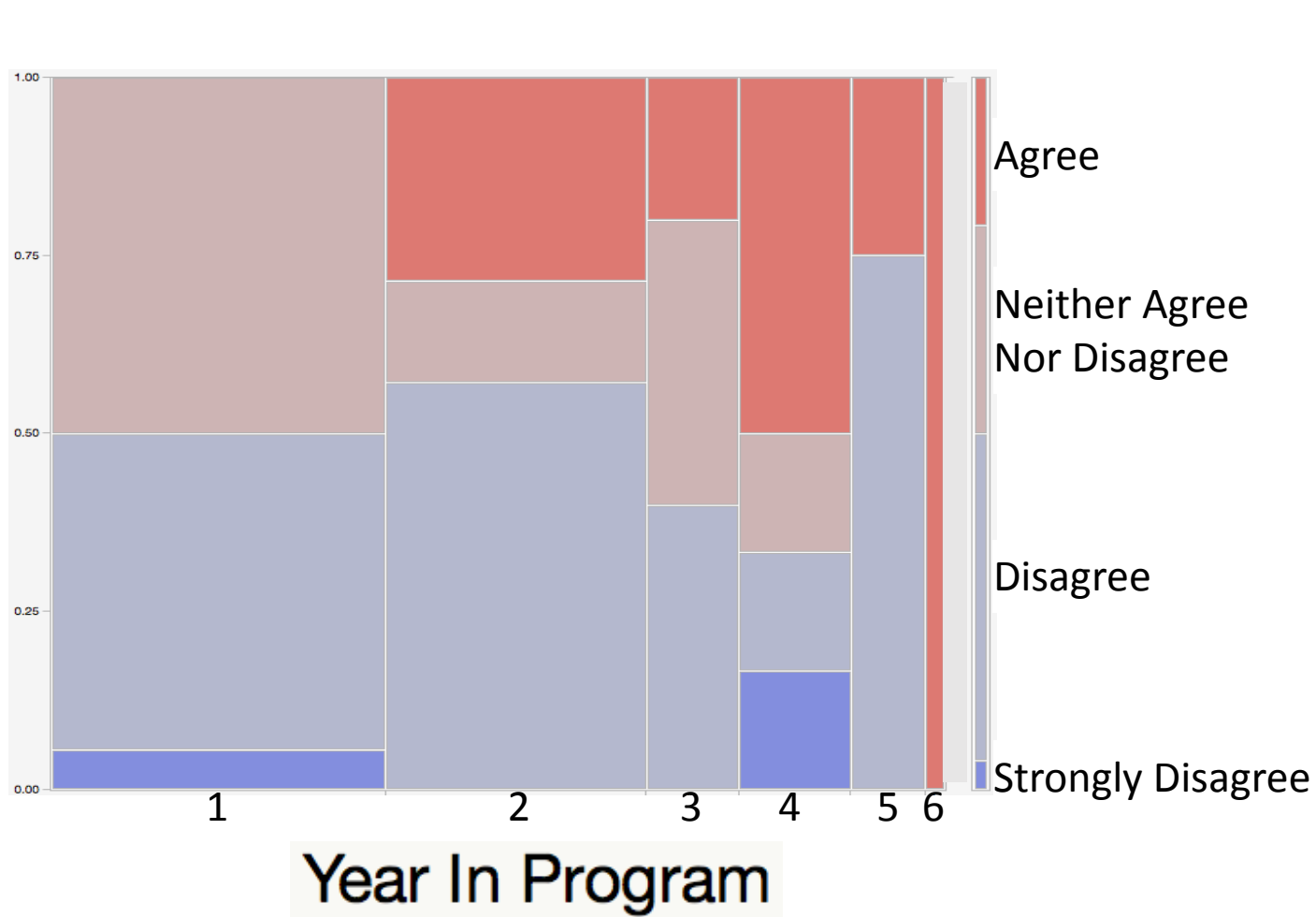
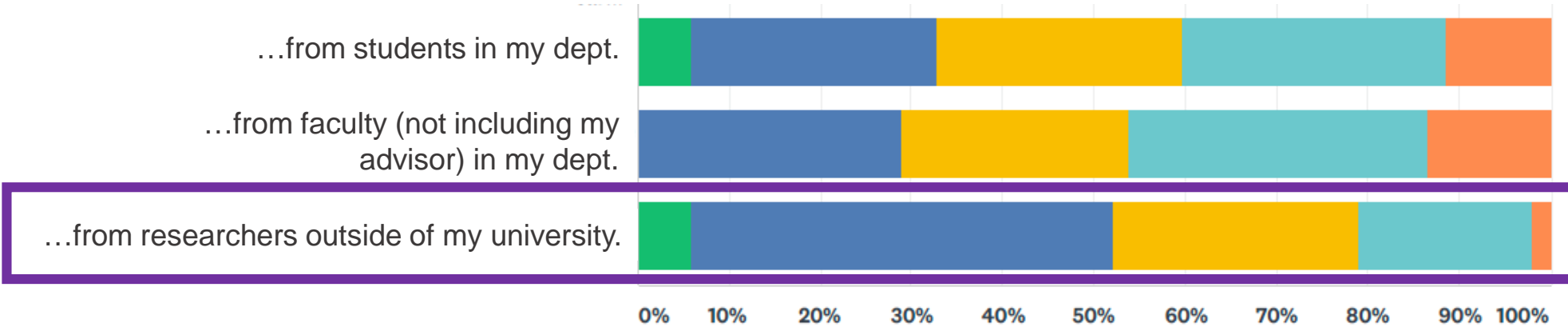

# Questions on Community (10 questions total)

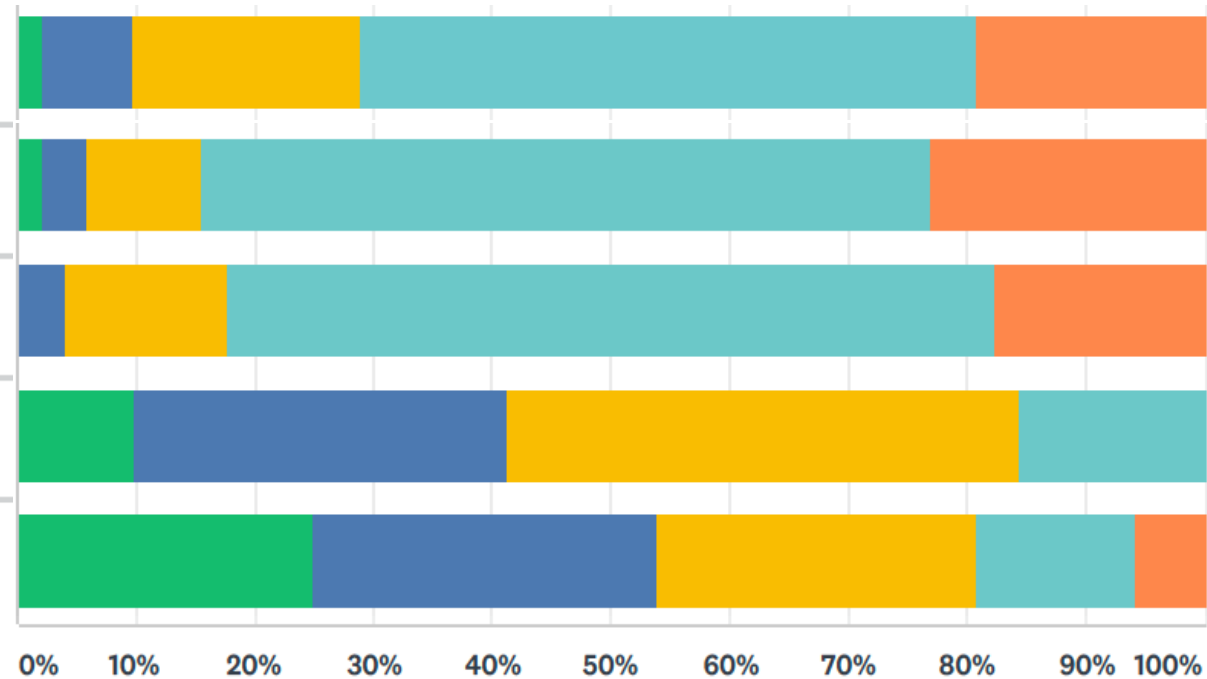
There is a positive community among PhD candidates in my department.

PhD candidates are treated with respect by faculty.

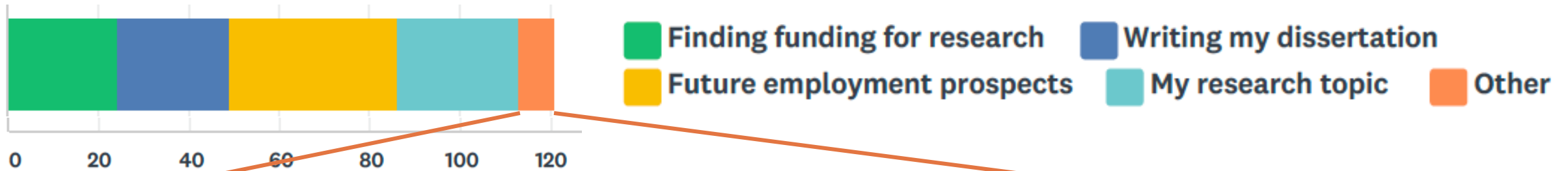
There is a healthy intellectual culture in the department.

Saving money towards my future, time and money for proper nutrition, getting to see daylight at some point during my day.

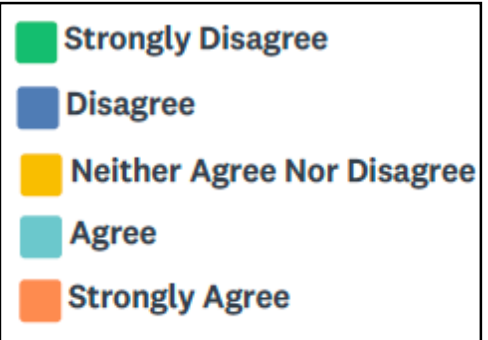
Can't emphasize on "future employment prospects" less

# Action Items

- Compare to benchmark data?

- Better messaging to incoming students about program's nuts and bolts, and expectations
- Department travel grants for PhD students
- Hold more industry "meet and greet" events for PhD and MS students
- Next year, include question about post-graduation plans: academia, industry, unsure

# Misc. Comments

- There are several courses which are listed but have not been offered in many years. Often these are higher level courses which have more specific topics.
- I do not think anyone should TA in their first semester unless they request to
- I would have liked to know more information about the logistics of the program WAY sooner (perhaps at least a month in advance) AND on an individual basis (i.e. stipend payout and timelines, less vagueness about rotations, health insurance...
- There's not as much support at BU for incoming students as my friends who started programs at other schools.
- The department could provide more easily accessible resources and documentation for graduate students.
- The format of the qualification exam is strange
