Questions for The Dialogue

Question One:

Tell us about an experience you've had –at any time in your life- when you were aware of an economic difference –a difference in economic resources- between you and one or more others, and its effects on you. This should be an experience that affected you; that stuck with you; that still is alive in some way for you. 2 min. each

Question Two:

How does your faith commitment affect how you experience, feel about and manage economic differences between you and others, either in work, school, family, worship or on the street? **2 min. each**

When facing this issue personally, either in your thinking or action, where do you find yourself puzzled about what to do?
