Pre-award costs up to 90 days prior to the budget period start date are allowed.</p> <p><b>ADMINISTRATIVE PRIVILEGES</b></p>						<p><b>Streamlined Noncompeting Award Process</b></p> <p>Waives the requirement to file an annual FSR 269 until the final budget period of the competitive segment.
