Tenure Track Faculty Position in Neurological Physical Therapy

Nominations and applications are invited for a full time tenure-track faculty position at the Assistant Professor level in the Department of Physical Therapy and Athletic Training at Boston University College of Health and Rehabilitation Sciences: Sargent College.

Ideal candidates will have a strong research program in the area of Neurological Physical Therapy that is supported, or has strong potential for support, by external funding sources. Candidates with a line of research pertaining to the department's initiatives in neuroscience and neurological rehabilitation, including the Center for Neurological Rehabilitation and the new Neurological Residency program, are particularly desired. Applicants should have a clear vision of their research direction, including clinical applications, and have demonstrated success working in interdisciplinary teams. The candidate will be responsible for carrying out an independent line of research, service, and teaching in the Department of Physical Therapy and Athletic Training and doctoral program in Rehabilitation Science, in his or her area of expertise.

The Department is housed within a vibrant academic and research community that includes the College of Health and Rehabilitation Sciences: Sargent College, Boston University Charles River and Medical campuses, and numerous educational and healthcare institutions of the metro Boston area. The Department offers professional programs in Athletic Training and Physical Therapy, a post-professional program in Physical Therapy and a new Neurological Residency program. Research faculty also participate in the interdisciplinary ScD program in Rehabilitation Science. The department houses the NIDRR Rehabilitation Research and Training Center in Arthritis (ENACT), the Center for Neurorehabilitation, several clinical service units including the Boston University Physical Therapy Center, and maintains close affiliations with the Athletic Enhancement Center and Athletic Training Services and world class medical centers in Greater Boston. BU Sargent College also offers professional and post professional degree programs in health science, human physiology, nutrition, occupational therapy, rehabilitation science, and speech, language and hearing sciences. Opportunities exist to join our innovative faculty and become involved in our exciting interdisciplinary collaborations within the department, Boston University and the greater Boston community.
