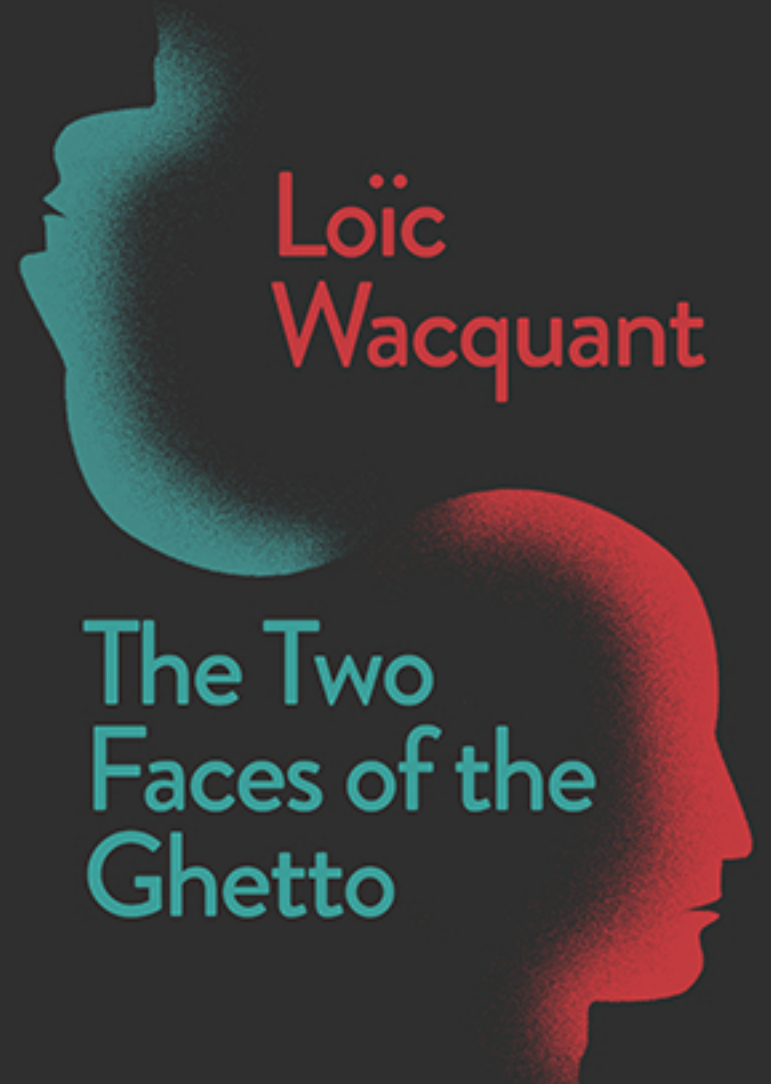

Loïc WACQUANT is Professor of Sociology at the University of California, Berkeley, and Researcher at the Centre de sociologie européenne, Paris. A MacArthur Prize Fellow, his research spans urban marginality, racial domination, the penal state, incarnation, and social theory. His books are translated in twenty languages and include the trilogy *Urban Outcasts* (2008), *Punishing the Poor* (2009), and *Deadly Symbiosis* (in press), as well as *The Two Faces of the Ghetto* (2017). He holds the 2016-2017 Pitt Professorship in American History and Institution at Cambridge University.
