

Loïc WACQUANT is Professor of Sociology at the University of California, Berkeley, and Researcher at the Centre de sociologie européenne, Paris. A MacArthur Prize Fellow, his research spans urban marginality, racial domination, the penal state, incarnation, and social theory. His books are translated in twenty languages and include the trilogy *Urban* Outcasts (2008), Punishing the Poor (2009), and Deadly Symbiosis (in press), as well as The Two Faces of the Ghetto (2017). He holds the 2016-2017 Pitt Professorship in American History and Institution at Cambridge University.
