## MBA/MPH Health Policy Management New Curriculum

Important Note: The dual degree curriculum is designed to be completed over 5 semesters, including one summer, which generates summer tuition charges. In the fall semester of the 2nd year, students will be given a tuition-neutral overload of 20 credits. Students who wish to reduce their summer credit load may petition to overload credits in other semesters, but may be expected to pay the resulting additional tuition charges accrued for that semester.
