Directions to Boston University Medical Campus

The Medical Center is located parallel to the expressway

FROM THE NORTH:

Follow Route 1 (via Mystic/Tobin Bridge) to Rt. 93 South. Take exit 18 (Mass Ave.). At traffic light, take right onto access road; stay in right lane. At end of access road, turn right onto Mass. Ave.

FROM LOGAN AIRPORT:

Go through the Ted Williams Tunnel follow signs to Expressway South. Take Exit 18 (Mass. Ave.). At traffic light, take right onto access road; stay in right lane. At end of access road, turn right onto Mass. Ave.

FROM THE SOUTH:

Take Expressway North (Route 93). Take exit 18 (Mass Ave.). Watch for signs. At the third traffic light take left onto access road; stay in right lane. At end of access road, turn right onto Mass. Ave.

FROM THE WEST:

Take the Massachusetts Turnpike (Route 90) East to end. Take Expressway South (Route 93). Take exit 18 (Mass Ave.) At traffic light, take right onto access road; stay in right lane. At end of access road, turn right onto Mass. Ave.

FROM NEW YORK/CONNECTICUT/RHODE ISLAND:

Take Route 95 North to Route 93 North. Take exit 18 (Mass. Ave.). Watch for signs. At the third traffic light turn left onto access road; stay in right lane. At end of access road, turn right onto Mass. Ave.

FROM MASSACHUSETTS AVE:

Take the first right onto Albany St. The School of Public Health is on the left, opposite the parking garage.

Destinations

For all destinations, paid parking is available at the Parking Garage located at 710 Albany St.

FOR BOSTON MEDICAL CENTER/HARRISON AVE. CAMPUS, 1 BOSTON MEDICAL CENTER PLACE:

From Mass. Ave take the second right onto Harrison Ave. Boston Medical Center/Harrison Ave. campus is the first driveway on your right. Valet parking is available for patients only.

FOR BOSTON MEDICAL CENTER/EAST NEWTON CAMPUS, 88 EAST NEWTON ST. and the BU SCHOOL OF DENTAL MEDICINE:

From Mass. Ave take first right onto Albany St. Take the second left onto E. Newton St. BU School of Dental Medicine is on the right side at 100 E. Newton St. BMC is on the right in the middle of the block at 88 E. Newton St.

FOR THE BU SCHOOL OF MEDICINE, 80 E. CONCORD ST.:

From Mass. Ave. take second right onto Harrison Ave. Take first right off Harrison Ave., which is East Concord St. Halfway down the block on the left side is 80 E. Concord St. Follow the foot path to the School of Medicine

FOR THE SCHOOL OF PUBLIC HEALTH, 715 ALBANY ST.:

From Mass. Ave. take the first right onto Albany St. The School of Public Health is located on your left at 715 Albany St. between East Concord and E. Newton Streets.

FOR THE DOCTOR'S OFFICE BUILDING (DOB), 720 HARRISON AVE.

From Mass. Ave. take the second right onto Harrison Ave. Go past E. Concord and E. Newton Streets on your right. The DOB at 720 Harrison Ave. is on your right just beyond E. Newton St. Paid parking is available in the garage at the DOB and valet parking is available for patients.

FOR THE PUBLIC HEALTH COMMISSION, 1010 MASS. AVE.:

From the access road turn left onto Mass. Ave. Seven blocks on the left is the Public Health Commission, 1010 Mass. Ave. (1010 is directly opposite Magazine St.) Paid parking is available in the lot across from 1010 Mass. Ave.

* The Silver Line (bus rapid transit-fewer stops) is the former # 49 bus route. It connects Dudley Station with Downtown Boston via Washington Street (which is two blocks from the medical center)

MBTA Fares and Pass Information

Several MBTA buses provide service to BUMC. There are many bus stops located on campus: 88 East Newton St. ('Newton Pavilion'), East Concord St., between Harrison Ave. and Albany St. and on Mass Ave. at Harrison Ave. Although the subway ('T') does not run directly to the medical area, there is bus transportation from many 'T' stops to the

School. Bus one-way fare = \$1.25 with a Charlie Card, \$1.50 without a Charlie Card. Subway one-way fare = \$1.70 with a Charlie Card, \$2.00 without a Charlie Card.

MBTA Bus Service

There are five regular bus routes (Bus # 1, 8, 10, 47 & the Silver Line) and two express crosstown buses (CT1 & CT3) that serve the medical campus area. All buses operate seven days/week with less frequent service on the weekend <u>except</u> the CT1 and CT3 which do not operate on the weekend. The following buses stop at or near BUMC:

Bus #1: travels from Harvard Square, Cambridge (Red Line) to Dudley Bus Station via Massachusetts Ave, making stops at Central Square, Cambridge (Red Line), Hynes Convention Center/ICA and Symphony (Green Line), and Mass Ave. Station (Orange Line). This bus is free from Mass Ave. Station with a bus transfer or a 'T' subway pass. This bus operates every 12 minutes during peak hours.

Bus # 8: travels from the JFK/University of Massachusetts, Boston "Harbor Point" Campus (Red Line/Commuter Rail), to Kenmore Square (Green Line) via BUMC. It connects with the Orange Line/Commuter Rail at Ruggles Station. Buses operate every 15-20 minutes during peak hours.

Bus # 10: travels from Copley Station (Green Line) to City Point in South Boston and connects BUMC with Back Bay (Orange Line/Commuter Rail) and Andrew Station (Red Line). Buses operate every 20 minutes during peak hours.

Bus # 47: travels from Central Square, Cambridge (Red Line) to Broadway Station, South Boston (Red Line). This bus stops at Fenway Station (Green Line) and Ruggles Station (Orange Line/Commuter Rail). This bus runs through the Fenway and Longwood area, to Dudley Bus Station, and then down Massachusetts Ave. to BUMC. Buses operate every 20 minutes during peak hours.

Silver Line: travels on Washington St.(2 blocks from the medical campus) from Dudley Square to Downtown Crossing, Boston (Close to Red/Orange Lines). It connects BUMC to New England Medical Center Station (Orange Line) and Chinatown Station (Orange Line). Service is provided every 5 minutes during peak hours. Subway passes are accepted on the Silver Line.

Crosstown Bus #1 (CT1): travels from BUMC to Central Square, Cambridge (Red Line), connecting with Massachusetts Ave. Station (Orange Line), Symphony Station (Green Line) and Hynes/ICA (Green Line). Bus operates from 6:00 am to 6:30 p.m. every 15 minutes during peak hours. Subway passes are accepted on crosstown buses. **Service operates Monday - Friday only.**

Crosstown Bus #3 (CT3): travels from Andrew Station (Red Line) and Beth Israel Deaconess Hospital, (Longwood) connecting with Ruggles Station on the Orange Line/Commuter Rail and the Museum Stop (Green Line). Buses operate every 20 minutes during peak hours. Service begins from Ruggles Station to the Medical Center at 4:00 am with the last bus leaving Longwood at 8:16 p.m. Subway passes are accepted on Crosstown buses. **Service to the Medical Center operates Monday- Friday only.**


