Environmental Health Concentration Requirements for 2013-2014 Academic Year, continued

Required Concentration Courses			
EH concentrators must take a minimum of 16 credits of EH courses numbered 700 or above or courses that carry environmental health concentration credit, though students are strongly encouraged to take a minimum of 18 credits to get a sufficient foundation in key content areas. EH708, EH717, and EH765 do not carry concentration credit. All concentrators must take EH725 and EH768 as part of these 16 required credits and earn a B- or better in both classes. The capstone course in which the concentrator completes the culminating experience counts toward these 16 required credits. These courses also carry Environmental Health credit: EP752, EP755, & PH825. Write in EH concentration courses completed in addition to EH725 & EH768; if in progress, write "pending" and semester taking.
