**Environmental Health Concentration Requirements for 2011-2012 Academic Year, continued**

**Required concentration courses.** EH concentrators must take a minimum of 16 credits of EH courses numbered 700 or above or courses that carry environmental health concentration credit, not including the core course EH765 or EH708. All concentrators must take EH768, Toxicology, as part of these 16 required credits and earn a B- or better in this class. The Culminating Experience also counts toward these 16 required credits. The following courses also carry Environmental Health credit: EP752, EP755, & PH825. Write in EH concentration courses completed in addition to EH768; if in progress, write "pending" and semester taking

The culminating course can be counted as part of the 16 required EH concentration credits.
