## Epidemiology Requirements for 2014-2015 Academic Year

<b>Required Concentration Courses</b>		
A total of 16 credits of concentration credits are required. The core courses on page 1 do not count as concentration credit. Of the 16 concentration credits, 8 credits must be from courses beginning EP700 or above. Only 4 credits of 900-level EP courses may apply. Check that course is completed.
