Environmental Health Concentration Requirements for 2010-2011 Academic Year, continued

Required concentration courses. EH concentrators must take a total of 16 credits of EH courses numbered 700 or above or courses that carry environmental health concentration credit, not including the core course EH765. All concentrators must take EH768, Toxicology, as part of these 16 required credits. The Culminating Experience also counts toward these 16 required credits. The following courses also carry Environmental Health credit: EP752, EP755, & PH825. Write in EH concentration courses completed in addition to EH768; if in progress, write "pending" and semester taking

Culminating Experience: Students must declare one of the following courses as their culminating class in the semester in which they are enrolled and participate in the culminating experience day held that semester. The culminating experience presentation is graded pass/fail. The following classes are approved as culminating classes in the concentration; circle the course selected. The department coordinator will confirm participation in the culminating experience day. These courses can be counted as part of the 16 required EH concentration credits.
