APPLICATION FOR FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE 2009/2010**

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

To be considered for financial assistance, you must:

1. be enrolled in the MSW degree program at the School of Social Work on **at least a half-time basis**;
2. be a citizen or permanent resident of the United States;
3. maintain the enrollment status required by the type of assistance;
4. maintain a GPA of 3.0 once enrolled to have assistance continued in successive year(s);
5. not be in default on any federal funds.

APPLICATION PROCEDURE AND DEADLINES

- Full-time and part-time applicants who are citizens or permanent residents of the United States should complete this SSW Application for Financial Assistance (unfortunately, we are unable to award financial assistance to international students).
- On or after January 1, 2009, submit a 2009/2010 Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) or the Renewal FAFSA to Federal Student Aid Programs. You may complete the form on-line at www.fafsa.ed.gov. **The FAFSA should be submitted by March 2, 2009, using the School Code 002130.**
- A limited number of full-tuition, half-tuition, and other scholarships will be awarded to full-time students. Eligible part-time students will be awarded scholarships of up to \$2,000. For continuing students, scholarship award decisions will be based upon GPA.
- Applications to apply for several named scholarships will also be available. You may submit the applications of your choice by the deadline, which will be April 1, 2009. We expect to announce the decisions of those scholarship awards to continuing students on or about May 30, 2009.
