Please include a brief assessment (one paragraph within the one page) of your personal financial need. You may apply for as many of these scholarships as you want, but a **different** statement must be submitted for each scholarship. All application material is considered confidential and will be reviewed only by the School's Financial Aid Office and the Award Selection Committee.
- Bring or send your statement(s) to the BUSSW Financial Aid Office no later than April 9, 2018.
- <u>Please Note:</u> You must have applied for financial aid within your admissions application (or separately if your did not) to be considered for any of these scholarships.
