- Demonstrated potential for effective teaching
- Demonstrated potential for scholarly contributions
- Ability to contribute in the areas of service and outreach within the university and community

Preferred qualifications:

- Doctorate in social work
- A record of successful teaching at graduate and/or undergraduate level
- Experience and ability to teach social work practice
- Experience and ability to teach in all of the following areas: practice, policy, research, and human behavior (position # 998255). The second position requires a particular emphasis placed on the ability to teach policy and research related courses (position # 998050)
- Experience and ability in addressing human diversity and at-risk populations
- Interest and ability to seek and secure external grant funds
- Demonstrated record of scholarly work and contributions
- Interest and ability to use technologies in teaching and research
- Experience and ability to teach online courses
