Boston University School of Social Work Non-Matriculating Student Policy

In order to be eligible to take classes as a non-matriculating student, you must have received a bachelor's degree from an accredited College or University. We reserve the right to ask for a transcript to be submitted along with your application. Please submit application to Registrar, Jennifer Rosenberg Warner, at jarose@bu.edu.

Eligible non-matriculating students may take up to three courses (9 credits) selected from the following four course options, on a seats-available basis, on the Charles River Campus:

- HB 720 Human Behavior
- WP 700 Social Welfare Policy I

- WP 701 Social Welfare Policy II (pre-req: WP 700)
- SR 743 Research I

To take these courses on one of our off campus sites, students need permission from the Off Campus Programs Director for that location. For online courses, permission is required from the Online Programs Administrator. All pending space availability. If you are or will be applying for admission to the BU School of Social Work's MSW program and you wish to apply the credits toward the degree, grades of B (3.0) or better are required for all courses taken as a non-matriculating student. Please note that enrolling as a non-matriculating student does not guarantee admission. Applicants who have been denied admission previously are not eligible to apply for non-matriculating status.
