2. Students doing a **May to May placement for 16 hours per week:**

If the system says you are not in compliance when you are trying to register for your courses, please reenter your local address or check to see if your account is settled.

OFF-CAMPUS PROGRAMS' (OCP) REGISTRATION PROCEDURE

Off-Campus students will receive a tuition refund for a dropped course if it is dropped before the start date of the course. Keep in mind that a student must be registered for six credits per semester to be eligible for financial aid.

Students with modified program plan should follow their Program Plan. If you are not following the above program plan because you have either placed out of one of the courses, transferred

credits in or are taking a course in Boston, please contact your Program Director as soon as possible.
