All application material is considered confidential and will be reviewed only by the School's Financial Aid Office and the Award Selection Committee.
- Bring or send your statement(s) to the BUSSW Financial Aid Office no later than April 3, 2017.
- <u>Please Note:</u> You must have applied for financial aid within your admissions application (or separately if your did not) to be considered for any of these scholarships.
