Many classes for the Professional Education Programs are located at the General Classroom Building. However, others are located at various other buildings along campus. PLEASE CHECK YOUR CONFIRMATION FOR YOUR EXACT ROOM LOCATION & TIME OF THE PROGRAM.

The General Classroom Building (GCB, 750 Commonwealth Ave.) is above the Guitar Center, and sits on the opposite side of Commonwealth Ave. from the George Sherman Union (GSU). The GCB Building is 5 blocks from Kenmore Square. The entrance to the GCB Building is to the left of the red awnings that read "Guitar Center".

Parking: Parking is available for \$12 (price may vary) at the Kenmore Lot, 549 Comm. Ave., (outbound), which is just beyond Kenmore Square. Parking is also available at Lot N, 665 Comm. Ave (outbound) between Sherborn and Granby streets. A private lot is also available on the outbound side of Comm. Ave., at the corner of Granby Street and Comm. Ave. UNLESS YOU HAVE A PARKING PASS/PERMIT, DO NOT PARK in any lot that requires parking passes only. Violators are often towed. Limited metered parking is available along Comm. Ave & Bay State Rd.
