


Guide to Setting Up EBSCO Journal Alerts for ATLA journals

The EBSCO databases (including ATLA, New Testament Abstracts, Old Testament Abstracts, Religion and Philosophy Collection, the ATLA Catholic Periodical and Literature Index, and more) allow for you to set up journal alerts. This will send you an email alert with the citations or description of all articles in the newest issue, as it becomes available online.



Introduction

This guide will provide users of the Boston University School of Theology Library an overview of the e-resources available to them, including databases, online e-book sources, and STH dissertations.

First up, learn about the databases available at Boston University for your research, including your new best friend, the ATLA Religion Database with ATLASerials. Searchable things like journal articles; you will be provided citation information (so you know where to find that precious article needed for your paper due) and resource you are looking for!

Note that many articles we own appear in a search of our online catalog, but not all do! So make sure to continue your research by consulting our databases!




