**Study Hall:**

**Study Hall:** On Mondays, Tuesdays, Wednesdays and Thursdays, study hall is held from 4:00 PM – 5:45 PM. *Students should report to room B08 of the Language Center Classroom Building.* **There is a limit of thirty students per study hall session.**

**Extended Study Hall on Mondays and Wednesdays:** Study hall on Mondays and Wednesdays from 6:00 p.m. until 7:45 p.m. is strictly limited to students in good academic standing and who have jobs or extracurricular activities. A student wishing to attend either of these sections of tutoring must have a letter explaining the activity and why the activity is prohibiting him/her from attending the 4:00 p.m. session of study hall. The letter must also be signed by the employer, coach or person in charge of organizing the activity, and by the student's parent.

**Course Offerings:**

**SAT Math Prep:** This class will focus on study techniques for the SAT Math section, including practice math exercises.

**SAT Critical Reading Prep:** This class will focus on study techniques for the SAT Critical Reading section, including practice verbal exercises.

**SAT Writing Prep:** This class will focus on study techniques for the SAT Writing section, including practice writing exercises.

**MCAS Mathematics Preparation:** Sophomores should register for this class in preparation for the 2008 MCAS examination. Five units will be covered: Number Sense; Patterns, Relations and Functions; Geometry and Measurement; and Statistics and Probability. Students will be given workbooks and other test preparation materials.

**MCAS English Language Arts Preparation:** Sophomores should register for this class in preparation for the 2008 MCAS examination. Three units will be covered: Mastering Basic Reading Skills, Extending Your Reading Skills, and The Writing Process. Students will be given workbooks and other test preparation materials.

**UB Senior Work Shop: All UB seniors must sign up for this course!!!** This class will assist seniors in **all** aspects of the college application process. **The class meets once a week for two hours.** For UB Seniors there are two sections to pick from: one on Mondays and one on Wednesdays. Both meet in the School of Education IMC Back lab from 4 to 6 p.m. and have a **limit of 15 students per class.**

**UBMS Senior Workshop: All UBMS seniors must sign up for this course!!!** This class will assist seniors in **all** aspects of the college application process. **The class meets** on Mondays in the Upward Bound Conference Room (305) from 4 to 6 p.m. and has a **limit of 15 students.**
