NUMBER OF COURSES: 14

PRINCIPLE COURSES

- AH111 - Introduction to Art History I: Antiquity to the Middle Ages
- AH112 - Introduction to Art History II: Renaissance to Today
- TWO non-Western introductory art history courses (AH215, 220, 222, 225)

ADDITIONAL COURSES

- SIX other art history courses; must be chosen from four of the six different areas of art history (non-Western, classical, medieval, Renaissance, Baroque, 18th century, 19th century, 20th century); FOUR must be at the 300 level or above
- ONE seminar course at the 400 level or above

RELATED COURSES

- Courses taken beyond the FOUR introductory surveys must include ONE course each from the following four groups:
 1. Ancient, Medieval, and Ancient American
 2. Asian African, and Islamic
 3. Renaissance, Baroque, and 18th Century
 4. 19th and 20th Century, including American
