

Dorm Rules

These rules are set forth to ensure the safety and fun of our campers and staff. Some may sound self-explanatory, but all of these rules are necessary to keep things enjoyable and productive. Please return one copy of the rules signed, the other is for you to keep.

1. All dorm keys & passes *must* be returned upon departure of the camp. Boston University's policy requires keys and Boston University passes be returned within 48 hours of the camper's checkout time. Failure to return a pass will result in a twenty-five (\$25) dollar charge and failure to return a key will result in a one hundred (\$100) dollar charge.
2. Any camper who wishes to leave the dormitory to go to a store or coffee shop within one block must go with another camper, check in and out with a camp counselor, and have a signed *Permission to Walk in Boston* form from a parent or guardian indicating that she has permission to leave the dormitory on file.
3. Please be courteous and respectful to all other campers and Boston University employees (security guards, custodians, fellow campers, and counselors).
4. There will be no smoking, consumption of alcohol, or use of drugs.
5. No guests other than fellow campers, counselors and coaches will be allowed in your dorm rooms.
6. Curfew will be set at 10:00 PM. You **MUST** be in your dorm at that time. You will be getting up early and working hard, you will need your sleep.
7. Disrespect to equipment or materials, poor language and use of degrading language towards other campers and staff will not be tolerated.
8. Vandalism of any kind will not be tolerated.

I have read and understand these rules. I realize that disregard for any of these rules may result in my dismissal from the camp and being sent home without refund.
