Type I awards (up to \$3,000) to cover expenses such as travel, equipment, conference fees, child care, and hosting collaborators. Proposals accepted on a rolling basis.

Type II awards. (\$20k) Last round completed Spring 2010.

Available to STEM tenure-track faculty women

WIN Colloquia. Win will help to bring distinguished women scientists and engineers to campus to present a technical seminar and to meet with graduate students and faculty within departments or centers (Partial travel support and reception funding available)
