3. **Students in the fall semester need to be aware of the assessment components that are required for each of their chosen modules. Semester 1 examinations take place every January, so Study Abroad students are advised to take modules that contain 100% continuous assessment in order to prevent having to return to DCU to sit examinations in January.**
4. It is highly advisable that you choose modules from the same year and programme. Choosing from different years/ programmes may result in class and examination timetable clashes. **Students are responsible for their own timetables and the University cannot change timetables to suit individual students.**
