

Biagio Conte, MD, (CAS'52) Italian Studies Fund Stipend Application

Stipend Information

The Biagio Conte, MD, (CAS'52) Italian Studies Fund, is a permanently endowed fund, providing annual stipend awards to students participating in experiential learning opportunities or immersive educational experiences in Italy, with a strong preference for undergraduate students from the College of Arts & Sciences who are pursuing the study of Italian language, history, and culture at Boston University. Recipients will be selected by the Dean of the College of Arts & Sciences or their designee, in consultation with the Study Abroad Office. It is the donor's wish to support students for whom studying in Italy will advance their knowledge and further study of Italian culture and language.

One or more awards will be made out each semester for \$500-2500, awarded as a check. The stipend is intended to be used to support the cost of the experiential learning opportunity in Italy.

Any full-time BU undergraduate or graduate student who plans to study abroad in Italy is eligible to apply, including international students. There is no minimum length for the learning opportunity or experience in Italy. Students do not have to participate in a BU Study Abroad program to receive the stipend, but preference will be given to students studying in Italy through the Study Abroad office. Preference will also be given to students with financial need if they meet the criterion listed above.

Eligibility Guidelines:

- In order to be awarded the Biagio Conte, MD (CAS'52) Italian Studies Fund Stipend, you must be participating in an experiential learning opportunity in Italy.
- Must be a full-time undergraduate or graduate BU student.
- Preference given to College of Arts and Sciences undergraduate students studying Italian language, history, and culture on a BU Study Abroad program with financial need.
- International students are eligible to apply.
- Students are not required to participate in a BU Study Abroad program.
- Incomplete applications will not be considered.
- Late applications may be considered.

Notification of Award:

- Students will be awarded a check for the award amount.
- Students must complete a W-9 in order to receive the check
- Once checks are processed, students will be notified via email and given information on how they will receive the check.
