STANDARDIZED TEST POLICY

BU does not require the SAT or ACT for fall 2021 and spring 2022 applicants. If English is not a student's first language, we require proof of English proficiency.

ENGLISH PROFICIENCY

BU accepts the TOEFL (iBT), the IELTS, and Duolingo English Test (DET). Students admitted into the Class of 2024 had an average TOEFL score of 107. View the minimum required scores and information about English proficiency at bu.edu/admissions/apply/international.

As an additional way to demonstrate English, applicants may schedule an optional interview with InitialView or Vericant. Please note that the submission of a TOEFL, IELTS, or DET is also required.

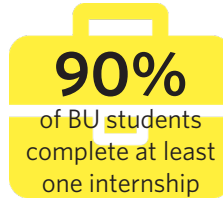

SPECIAL ACADEMIC PROGRAMS & OPPORTUNITIES

BU Hub: Our innovative University-wide general education program prepares students for today's interconnected, global, and fast-paced world. The Hub allows students to explore areas ranging from global citizenship to scientific and social inquiry to ethical reasoning.

Dual Degree Programs: Students earn two bachelor's degrees, i.e. a BS in journalism (COM) and a BA in international relations (Pardee).

Top-Ranked Programs: Many of BU's programs rank among the top 50 in the world, including Business & Economics (*Times Higher Education World University Rankings*) and Life Sciences & Medicine (*Quacquarelli Symonds*). *U.S. News & World*

Report ranks all of BU's health sciences programs in the top 25 in the nation. Other programs frequently ranked among the top in the nation include Biomedical Engineering, Film, and Journalism.

Seven-Year Liberal Arts/Medical Education Program and MMEDIC:

Students complete a bachelor's degree and a medical degree in just seven years. A more traditional eight-year path is offered through MMEDIC, which offers early admission to BU's School of Medicine.

Kilachand Honors College: A four-year, interdisciplinary program led by top faculty that forges a uniquely modern approach to liberal education and the creative process.
