The Job

Hold For Maintenance will engage conversations happening online and in the social stratosphere about identity politics, policy, their sociopolitical implications, and replete with historical references. To achieve this, we must prioritize the use of evidence based, peer reviewed study as well as fact based, yet nuanced perspective. Therefore, will need an underwriter to serve on a team of two researchers to assist in the preparation of arguments for the most sought after segment of the show.

Responsibilities:

- Partner with a pop culture research specialist to submit weekly research notes and arguments for one topic per week.
- Pull relevant theories, data, case study developments, and historical references to support a balanced perspective of the purviews discussed.
- Pen expository notes in bullet form to explain perspectives garnered from what scholars are currently saying about the topic.

Qualifications:

- Must be an undergraduate or grad student. Graduate students preferred.
- A passion for the education and empowerment of minority groups.
- Must hold a major, degree, or be enrolled in an interdisciplinary degree program such as African American Studies, Women's Studies, Multicultural

Studies, or American Studies. Students in the field of history, psychology, sociology, or anthropology with a focus in any of the aforementioned interdisciplinary studies may also be considered.

Compensation:

- An **introductory** stipend of **\$400 per month for a 90 day probationary period**. A rate increase will be discussed at the end of this period.

Submission Requirements:

- To qualify for consideration applicants must share the following:
 - An academic resume or curriculum vitae reflecting their current area of study and past research projects/experience.
 - A previously written Op/Ed article to show writing style and ability
 - Course load/schedule.
 - A written statement of reference from a professor or academic advisor to speak to your ability to perform this role.
