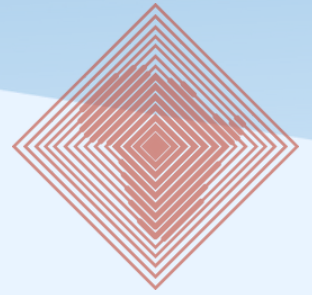


Unpacking Foreign Military Presences in Africa Webinar Series for 6-12 teachers

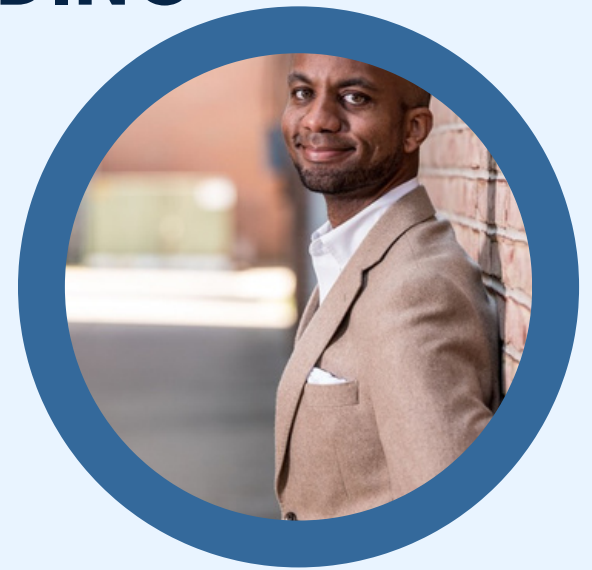


WEBINAR 1: UNDERSTANDING THE WAGNER GROUP
