

BU surveys its undergraduate degree recipients each year to learn about paths taken following graduation, including employment, graduate school, military service, and volunteer or service activities.

Data collection started prior to graduation and concluded in December 2018. Methods included a web-based survey, telephone calls, and LinkedIn research.
