

BU surveys its undergraduate degree recipients each year to learn about paths taken following graduation, including employment, graduate school, military service, and volunteer or service activities.

Data collection started prior to graduation and concluded in December 2019. Methods included web-based and telephone surveys, and research through LinkedIn and the National Student Clearinghouse.
