



Transfer Credit

For CAS students exploring external credit

Students can search for external courses through two websites:

Transferology

Transferology sorts all previously evaluated transfer courses by the BU equivalent. For example, you can search for CAS EC 101 equivalents only.

Transfer Equivalency Site

The Transfer Equivalency Site (TES) is a database of all transfer courses previously evaluated for BU credit. It's sorted by institution.

Are you taking the transfer credit for...

A major?

Be sure to confirm with your major advisor if the specific requirement can be fulfilled via transfer credit.

A minor?

Be sure to confirm with the department of the minor if the specific requirement can be fulfilled via transfer credit.

CAS Requirement?

Great! Please review the requirement(s) to confirm the transfer course is equivalent to one of the approved BU courses:

- Language
- Natural Science w/ Lab

Elective units?

Keep in mind, transfer courses do not fulfill Hub requirements.

Transfer Credit Policy FAQs

- Transfer courses do not fulfill Hub requirements.
- You must earn a C or higher; Pass/Fail or Satisfactory/Unsatisfactory grades will not be accepted.
- The transfer course grades will not factor into your BU GPA.
- Non-BU international courses must adhere to a different process and policy. You can find more information on our [website](#).
- Credits will be awarded based on the external institution (e.g., 3 units at a semester system will be 3 units at BU; 3 units at a quarter system will be 2 units at BU).
- CAS students may not be enrolled at another institution while enrolled at BU in the fall and spring semesters.
 - Courses taken over the summer or while on a leave of absence are accepted.
- Official transcripts must be sent from the external institution directly to BU's Credit Evaluation Office.
