CELOP BU Housing and Dining Plan Rates

- Housing assignments are based on availability.
- Dining/Meal plans are used for all-you-can-eat meals at any of the residence dining rooms.
- If you are assigned a dormitory-style residence, you are required to choose one of the five dining plans.
- Each meal plan includes a set amount of Dining Points* based on the type of plan and length of your program.

Double, triple, and quad room (standard minimum rate)	\$5,630
Multiple-occupancy room in suite	\$5,990
Suite in 1019 Commonwealth Avenue and Myles	\$6,440
Single with private bath	\$7,935
Single without private bath	\$7,395
Apartment with two or more students	\$7,510*
Apartment with one student	\$10,030*
Single room in apartment	\$9,035*

*In apartment-style residences, participation in the dining program is not required.

Unlimited Plan (Unlimited meals plus Dining Points)	Unlimited	\$222.50/Semester	\$3,255	Unlimited visits to any residence dining room during any meal period, with Dining Points
14 Plus (14 meals/week plus Dining Points)	14 meals/week	\$285/Semester	\$3,070	Up to 14 meals per week at any residence dining room, plus Dining Points for additional food purchases
Kosher Plan (11 meals/week plus Dining Points)	11 meals/week	\$305/Semester	\$3,070	Access to all meals served in the Fresh Fuel at Granby Commons Room, including Shabbat meals, festive meals, and Passover Seders, plus Dining Points for additional food purchases
330 Plan (165 meals/semester plus Dining Points)	165 meals/semester	\$352.50/Semester	\$3,070	165 meals for the semester, with the flexibility to carry over from week to week and from Fall to Spring semester, plus Dining Points for additional food purchases
250 Plan (125 meals/semester plus Dining Points)	125 meals/semester	\$665/Semester	\$3,070	125 meals for the semester, with the flexibility to carry over from week to week and from Fall to Spring semester, plus Dining Points for additional food purchases

Spring 2023 Boston University Housing Arrival Information

When will I find out where I will be living?

If you complete and submit the online housing application before you arrive in Boston, you'll be able to get your room assignment through the online portal once it has been confirmed. You will receive an email when your assignment is available online.

When can I move-in to my Spring 2023 Boston University Housing?

New spring semester students will schedule their arrival to campus housing for Spring 2023. Students MUST select an appointment date and time for their move-in from January 13th through January 18th, 2023, in the housing application. The deadline to register your arrival date is November 30, 2022.

What should I do if I arrive in Boston after 4pm or on a weekend day (Saturday or Sunday)?

If you arrive after 4pm or on a non-move-in weekend day and you know your residence assignment, go to your residence office (included with your residence assignment in [My Housing Portal](#)) to pick up your room key. If you do not know your residence assignment when you arrive, you will need to stay in a hotel at your own expenses until BU Housing is open the next business day. BU Housing must process your online application before you can be assigned to on-campus housing and before move-in arrangements can be made.

When do I move-out of my Spring 2023 Boston University Housing?

You must move-out of your housing by Saturday, May 13th, 2023 by noon.

IMPORTANT: This is a binding contract. There are no housing cancellations. By entering your electronic signature (BU ID number) you are confirming that you want to live in Boston University housing.
