CELOP BU Housing and Dining Plan Rates

- ***CELOP students ages 17-25 can choose to live in BU Housing for eligible programs in the fall and spring semesters.***
- Housing assignments are based on availability.
- Dining/Meal plans are used for all-you-care-to-enjoy dining halls at any of the residence dining rooms.
- If you are assigned a dormitory-style residence, you are required to choose one of the dining plans.
- Each meal plan includes a set amount of Dining Points* based on the type of plan and length of your program. See details at <https://www.bu.edu/housing/living/rates/2024-25-academic-year-rates/>.

Double, triple, and quad room (standard minimum rate)	\$6,090
Multiple-occupancy room in suite	\$6,480
Suite in 1019 Commonwealth Avenue or Myles	\$6,965
Single with private bath	\$8,585
Single without private bath	\$7,995
Apartment with two or more students	\$8,120*
Apartment with one student	\$10,845*
Single room in apartment	\$9,770*

*In apartment-style residences, participation in the dining program is not required.

Open Access Unlimited Plan (Unlimited meals plus Dining Points)	Unlimited Meals	\$250/Semester	\$3,420	Unlimited visits to any residence dining room during any meal period, with Dining Points
Open Access + Unlimited meals plus Dining Points)	Unlimited Meals	\$450/Semester	\$3,625	Unlimited visits to any residence dining room during any meal period, with Dining Points
Kosher Plan (11 meals/week plus Dining Points)	11 meals/week	\$350/Semester	\$3,420	Access to all meals served in the Fresh Fuel at Granby Commons Room, including Shabbat meals, festive meals, and Passover Seders, plus Dining Points for additional food purchases
Weekly 10 + (10 meals per week /semester plus Dining Points)	10 meals/week	\$750/Semester	\$3,625	10 visits per week to all-you-care-to-enjoy dining halls

Fall 2024 Boston University Housing Arrival Information

When will I find out where I will be living?

If you complete and submit the online housing application before you arrive in Boston, you'll be able to get your room assignment through the online portal once it has been confirmed. You will receive an email when your assignment is available online.

When can I move-in to my Boston University Housing?

You can move-in to your housing on Monday, September 16, 2024, Tuesday, September 17, and Wednesday, September 18 from 10am-4pm.

When do I move-out of my Boston University Housing?

You must move-out of your housing by Saturday, December 21, by noon.

What should I do if I arrive in Boston after 4pm or on a weekend day (Saturday or Sunday)?

If you arrive after 4pm or on a non-move-in weekend day and you know your residence assignment, go to your residence office (included with your residence assignment in the MyHousing online portal) to pick up your room key. If you do not know your residence assignment when you arrive, you will need to stay in a hotel at your own expenses until BU Housing is open the next business day. BU Housing must process your online application before you can be assigned to on-campus housing and before move-in arrangements can be made.

IMPORTANT: This is a binding contract. There are no housing cancellations. By entering your electronic signature (BU ID number) you are confirming that you want to live in Boston University housing.
