Purpose of this form

The [Code of Ethics of the National Association of Schools of Music](http://nasm.arts-accredit.org/index.jsp?page=Standards-Handbook) (NASM: <http://nasm.arts-accredit.org/index.jsp?page=Standards-Handbook>) states that “a transferring student who has not completed a degree program can be considered eligible for financial aid during the first term of enrollment in the new institution only if the music executive of the school from which the student is transferring specifically approves...
