Eligibility

- BU graduate and undergraduate piano majors enrolled in ML applied lessons within a Boston University degree program

Competition date

- Wednesday March 29, 2023 ~ CFA Concert Hall
 - Time TBD; please reserve afternoon and evening (2 PM – 10 PM)

Application Process

- Completion and Submission of Declaration of Intent form no later than 5 PM Friday February 24, 2023
 - Must include instructor's signature and final repertoire – no changes after submission
 - Must be sent electronically as a PDF, attached to an email addressed to skibbe@bu.edu (please do not send via Docu-Sign or Google form)

Performance Requirements

- Recital program of solo piano repertoire; 55 – 65 minutes total, including Required Piece
- Complete works only
- All repertoire approved by applied teacher
- Complete program performed from memory
- Total program timing to include Required Piece (appr. 4 mins)

Required Piece

- New composition by BU SOM alumnus Anthony Greene
- Provided electronically to all applicants one month in advance (Tuesday February 28)
- Required piece does NOT require memorization

First Prize

- \$10,000 + Winner's Recital at Tsai Performance Center, to be scheduled during 2023-24 academic year

Second Prize

- \$5,000
